

A Suggested Depiction of Revelation Chapters 4 through 11

-Which Encompass about 10 1/2 Years Chronologically, from Rapture to Return

[chapters 12-19 provide supplementary information/recapitulation of this same period of time]

1997, 2006 **babylonfalls.org** reconciled chart material from »The Apocalypse: Exposition of the Book of Revelation (1900) by Joseph A. Seiss. This author posits a selective/partial/conditional Pre-Trib Rapture theory, and multiple/progressive raptures, i.e., Pre, Mid, & Post (cf. Enoch, Elijah, Jesus, John, the 2 Witnesses). Pre-Trib Rapture a reward *not* a right. **And**

- » The End of the Days: A Study of Daniel's Visions (1961)
- » Signs of His Coming: A Study of The Olivet Discourse (1962)
- » Before the Last Battle-Armageddon: A Survey of Bible Prophecy (1971) by Arthur E. Bloomfield, who contended for the rule that "If a prophecy has not been totally fulfilled in the past, then there will be a future complete fulfillment." Both authors similarly interpret Rev. 12 as symbolizing the Pre-Trib Rapture of Saints, *versus* the Ascension of Christ. Consider: the child is born and *immediately snatched up* 'to God, and to his throne;' whereas Jesus was born, lived, ministered in power for 3 years, died on the Cross, rose again on the third day, appeared to his disciples over a period of forty days, and ascended back into Heaven under his own power, 'slowly, deliberately, victoriously.'

Symbols
Women: symbolize churches.
In Rev. 12, this woman symb. the Saints alive at the time of the Pre-Trib Rapture. In Rev. 17, this other woman is a prostitute, and a false church system--as are the 2 women who will unite and carry her to her place in Shinar (Babylonia), Zechariah 5:5-11.

Numbers
12: Saints of either Old, or New Testaments (Rev. 21:12,14; Rev. 12:1 = N.T.).
24: Saints of *both* Testaments/Covenants (Rev. 4:4).

Matthew 24:4-6 Luke 21:8,9; 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12
Daniel 7:7-8, 24 [Antichrist resolves world crisis (Habakkuk 1), uproots 3 horns, leading to peace/prosperity/construction (1 Thes. 5:1-4), all before Rapture (see footnote*)]. Habakkuk 1&2; Matt. 24:36 25:13
Babylon: Note: Zech. 5:5-11 written *after* Isaiah 13:17-22, and *after* 539 B.C. Medo-Persian conquest of Babylon, so *Isaiah 13 is still unfulfilled*. Jeremiah 51:1-58 Revelation 17:1,2 18:1-20. Its final destruction: Isaiah 13:6, Jer. 51:62-64 = Rev. 18:21-24.
Tyre & Sidon: Note: Tyre has been continuously inhabited, e.g., Acts 21:7, to this present day, unlike Ezekiel 26:14,19, so *Ezekiel chapters 26-28 are still unfulfilled*. Isaiah 23 & 24.
Ark/Ensign/Banner: Ezek 20:34-38 Is. 18:3, 11:12 (Jer. 3:16,17).
***Daniel 7:9 = Rev. 4:4**, i.e., Post-Rapture thrones of 24 elders are set up [Ps. 149:5-9]. Note: Elders and living creatures are redeemed people, for they sing of redemption, Rev. 5:8,9.

RAPTURE REV. 12:5 [see 2:26-27 re. iron scepter] (In Rev. 4:1, John's rapture = type for THIS RAPTURE, and serves as chronological place-marker in the narrative. Rapture conditional: Rev. 3:10 Luke 21:34-36, 1 Peter 4:7,17. Woman of chapter 12 is left for now. "...For I have not found your deeds complete in the sight of my God (Rev. 3:2)."
Note: Rev. 3:4 clothing is soiled/ 'besmeared,' as with filth, compare with Rev. 7:14; Eph. 5:27. Note: the male child would symbolize a smaller body of vigilant Christians)

With the exception of 144,000 Jews [converted after the Pre-Trib Rapture (Micah 5:3), who are now sealed (Rev. 7:3-8) and remain on the earth (Matthew 10:23)] I, the Tribulation Saints are Raptured, Rev. 7:9-17

Note: Trumpets 1 through 7 are the same thing as Bowls 1 through 7
E.g., Rev. 11:15-19 = Rev. 16:16-21
I.e., "Trumpet 7" as seen in Heaven = "Bowl 7" from an earthly standpoint

Directed judgments hinder persecution: Rev. 12:16
Gospel is preached here to all from heavens: Matt. 24:14 Rev. 6:2 = Rev. 14:6,7
Note: Saints ride white horses, e.g., Rev. 19:14.
Note: redeemed people proclaim redemption. Greek *aggelos* translated "angel" or "messenger." Three uses of *aggelos*: **1)** Jesus Christ, 'The Angel of the LORD,' e.g., Rev. 10, cf. Gen. 18, Judges 13; **2)** created spiritual beings; **3)** men, Matt. 11:10, Rev. 6:2, 14:6,7

Revelation 8 - 10
Notes on 'The Seventy Sevens' of Daniel 9:20-27
-The weeks are *weeks of years*, so total is 7 x 70 = 490 years.
Jerusalem/Solomon's Temple destroyed, 2 Chron. 36:17-19.
Zerubbabel's Temple completed, 516 B.C., see Ezra, Neh. 7
Nehemiah approaches Artaxerxes, 445 B.C., Neh. 2:1-8.
+62 Messiah/anointed one arrives = Christ's First Coming.
+69 'Messiah cut off [crucified], but not for himself (KJV).'
Romans = typify 'People of Prince/ruler who shall come, destroy Jerusalem/Herod's Temple, 70 A.D.
(CHURCH AGE = TIME OUT/ PARENTHESIS IN TIME)
+1 Final Week = Daniel's 70th Week. 'Prince who shall come' is Antichrist. Dan. 2:40-45, 7:7; Rev. 13:1-3.

Zechariah 12:1-9, 14:1-8 Ezekiel 38
Joel 2:32b [Rev. 14:1] Joel 3:9-16 Habakkuk 3
Compare Zechariah 12:10-14 with Romans 11:25-32, and consider the distinction between Israel and the Church.
Note: "Tribulation refers to the people of God who are passing through a time of persecution." There are two periods of great tribulation: one for Christians, and this one for Jews.
Note: 'The Coming of Christ' may include from first rapture to coming with his armies: "The precise application has to be obtained from the context." Likewise for 'THE DAY OF THE LORD/CHRIST,' 'the last days,' 'the time of the end.' [mod. 2Feb06 by H.C.]
